



Join the Austmine mission to Kazakhstan's premier mining exhibition, *MiningWorld Central Asia* in Almaty, 15 - 17 September that is co-located with *KazComak*, the international construction exhibition, and *Kazmet*, a specialised metallurgy exhibition. Upon request, the mission can be optionally extended to visit key mine and processing sites (Kazakhmys, Kazzinc, Arcelor Mittal etc), 19 - 24 September.

Kazakhstan has a world-class mining sector with over 230 companies producing or processing coal, iron, steel, copper, lead, zinc, manganese, gold, aluminium, titanium sponge, uranium, barites, etc. Kazakhstan's mining sector is responsible for over 30% of export earnings and it is forecast to grow by 9.2% between 2008 and 2011. Kazakhstan has:

- 9th largest production of coal – 98 million tons
- 8th largest reserves of iron ore – 12.5 billion tons
- 2nd largest reserves of manganese ore – 600 million tons
- 30% of the world's chromite ore deposits
- 10th largest production of gold
- 25% of uranium.



Kazakhgold plans USD1 billion investments before 2015. There are also plans to increase Kazakhstan's annual copper cathode output by nearly 24% (95,000 tons) within five years.

In production terms, however, Kazakhstan's mining sector to date uses outdated equipment and the vast majority lack of cost-effective, safe and in general innovative technologies. As the industry develops, demand for new machinery will grow steadily, offering excellent opportunities for Australian suppliers.

MiningWorld Central Asia, 15-17 September

Austmine members will have the opportunity to exhibit and participate at Kazakhstan's leading mining show in Almaty (www.miningworld-centralasia.com), presenting the latest industry developments and gathering leading market players during the three days of the event. In 2009, the event attracted 246 companies from 24 countries represented and recorded 39% increase of first-time exhibitors. In 2010 confirmed exhibitors are: *Aramine, Atlas Copco, Boart LongYear, Bumar, Chetra, CFT, Continental Industrie, Engineering Dobersek, Dressta, FLSmidth, Kaz Can Corporation, Liebherr, Metso, Tyazhmash, Rohm & Haas, Sandvik* and many others.

Mine Site Visits, 19 – 24 September

Austmine will optionally offer mine site visits to gold, zinc and copper operations along the Charsk Gold Belt in the Karaganda Region and in East Kazakhstan. The key operators in these regions are Kazakhmys, Kazzinc and Alhambra Resources. Site visits will also include processing plants and smelters. Mission members will be able to view mine and plant operations first-hand and meet key site contacts face-to-face.
